

31 Days of Prayer for Your Husband

1. Father God in heaven I lift my husband up to you this day and I ask give him the mind of Christ, melt his heart toward you and give him a passion to lead our family as the Spiritual Leader, Provider and Protector teaching us in all Your ways that we may be careful to do all that your Word tells us to do so we may have peace, joy and much love in our home. I declare that my husband is a holy man, a man of prayer, mature in the Word of God and growing in his knowledge of you in Jesus righteous holy name. (1 Thessalonians 5:23, Colossians 4:12, Ephesians 1:18-19, 3:16-19, 6:18)
2. I declare and decree on the authority of the Word of God that my husband is growing in all 11 descriptions of a man who will not be shaken and he is a man after your own heart Father God. He worships You in the sanctuary, and He spends time in Your presence daily. He leads a blameless life and does what is right, speaking the truth from a sincere heart. He's not a gossip, and would never harm someone else and he loves his neighbors as himself and would not speak evil of our friends. He hates sin, honors faithful Christians who live godly lives and he keeps his promises even when it hurts. He lends money without charging interest, and he cannot be bribed to tell a lie - he is a person who will stand firm forever in Jesus precious name. (Psalms 15)
3. I declare and decree in Jesus Name and it is established that my husband is a man of contentment. He understands it is better to have little, with the fear of the Lord, than to have great treasure and inner turmoil. He has a heart of gratitude and thankfulness. He knows true godliness with contentment is itself a great wealth - after all we came in this world with nothing and will leave this world with nothing but treasures we have laid up in the Kingdom. We are grateful for food and clothing and our family is content with what we have. (Proverbs 15:16, Philemon 4:11, 1 Timothy 6:6-8, Hebrews 13:5)
4. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has learned to take every thought captive and bring every thought into obedience with the Word of God and Christ, and he is not conformed to this world and has the mind of Christ. (Romans 12:2, 2 Corinthians 10:5)
5. I declare in Jesus Name and on the authority of the Word of God my husband seeks God with all his heart and has great favor with God and man, he is led by the Spirit every moment of his day; completely dependent on you Abba Father - You are our Jehovah Jireh our provider. (Psalms 119:1-2, Proverbs 3:3-6, Psalms 23:1, Philippians 4:19)
6. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is captivated by my love and he's passionate about his love for me and looks for ways to spend time with me and love me as I do likewise with him. (Proverbs 5:18-19)

7. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is a man of courage and bold.
(Deuteronomy 31:6, 2 Chronicles 19:11)
8. I declare in Jesus mighty matchless name my husband has great wisdom to lead his family physically, emotionally, mentally, financially and spiritually. He is healthy & whole & looks to Jehovah Rophe our healer. (Ephesians 1:17-19)
9. I declare in Jesus Name my husband looks at the plank in his own eye before seeing other's sawdust and so do I, He truly loves unconditional and he's a loving husband, dad and spiritual father. (Matthew 7:3, Luke 15:11-32)
10. I declare in the holy name of Jesus my husband is a called man, set apart, and chosen, not driven, with goals directed by the Holy Spirit, He sees the end from the beginning. He is a visionary. (1 Corinthians 9:24-27, Habakkuk 2:2-3)
11. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is a man of prayer, guarding his heart and mind, putting into practice what he has been taught, learned, heard and seen. He is very perceptive. (Philemon 4:4-9)
12. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has a strong spirit of discernment and he stands firm against the schemes of the devil and resists Satan, putting on the whole armor of God and puts him under his feet in all circumstances. (Ephesians 6:10-18, James 4:7)
13. I declare in Jesus Name and on the authority of the Word of God my husband is spiritually mature and he has put away childish things, cultivating - understanding and involved in the deeper truths of the gospel, and he is disciplined overcoming temptation. (1 Corinthians 13:11, 14:20, Ephesians 4:13, Hebrews 5:14, 1 John 2:14)
14. I declare in the Mighty Matchless name of Jesus my husband covers me and our family, he is the priest, provider and protector and he makes me holy, cleansing me by the washing with water through the Word. (Ephesians 5:26)
15. I declare in Jesus Name my husband depends on Jesus Christ alone for his happiness not me or someone else and so do I. (Hebrews 3:17-19)
16. I declare in Jesus Name my husband takes authority over the attacks of the enemy by force - recognizing that we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, against the rulers of darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. He realizes that every morning it is important to get up and put on the whole armor of God that we may be able to stand against the wicked plans and schemes of the devil. We stand together in agreement in truth, righteousness, peace, faith, and salvation for they are more than words. We must apply them to our daily walk. The Word of God is an indispensable weapon we must use daily and prayer is equally important. I declare we pray hard and long. Thank you Father God for helping us to

keep our eyes focused on You and help us to be accountable to each other. (Ephesians 6:11-18, 1 Thessalonians 5:8)

17. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has supernatural energy and strength in the midst of his busy schedule and the Lord supernaturally empowers him. (Isaiah 40:31, Ephesians 3:14-19)
18. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has a burden to see the lost come to know Jesus Christ, to train them and raise them up as leaders and send them out into their purpose and destiny. (Matthew 28:19-20)
19. I declare in Jesus Name and on the authority of the Word of God my husband is faithful, committed to me, Christ and he is a man after God's own heart, quick to repent and quick to obey, and quick to say I'm sorry when he makes a mistake. (Proverbs 13:20)
20. I declare in Jesus Name my husband's self-image is a reflection of the Lord's thoughts toward him. (Ephesians 1:17-19, Romans 12:3, Jeremiah 1, Psalm 139)
21. I declare and decree therefore it is established in Jesus Name my husband is God's property, and the devil cannot touch him for the blood of Jesus covers him and the enemy cannot cross the bloodline. (Proverbs 4:1-14, Psalms 91)
22. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has a strong spirit of discernment, and he is not a man with sin, un-forgiveness or bitterness in his heart, he is pure in heart. (Matthew 13:8-10, Ephesians 4:31-32)
23. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is a man of love, he is gentle, kind, and affectionate toward me. And he has tough love for our children and spiritual children. (1 Corinthians 13:4-7, Romans 12:8-10, Ephesians 5:25)
24. I declare and decree in Jesus Mighty Name my husband has the fruit of the Spirit operating in him and the gifts of the Spirit are operating in him and his life. (Galatians 5:22-23, John 15:8)
25. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is humble and the anointing flows through him as he covers his family and walks in God's plan and purpose for his life. The gift of God in him is being birthed out. (1 Peter 5:2-6 & Jeremiah 29:11-13)
26. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is growing in character daily - he is a man of integrity and he honors his word. (2 Peter 1:5-8)
27. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has a clear conscience & he is a man of integrity. (1 Peter 3:16-18)

28. I declare in Jesus Name no weapon formed against my husband or our family can prosper and every tongue that rises up against him shall fall for this is the heritage of the children of the Most High God. (Proverbs 2:8, Isaiah 54:17)
29. I declare in Jesus Name my husband is a good time manager, time is his weapon and he is a good steward of our finances and debt cancellation is operating in our lives. (Ephesians 5:15)
30. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has a song in his heart, the joy of the Lord and peace of God flow through him and he is an encourager. (Psalm 33:3, 40:3, Job 35:10)
31. I declare in Jesus Name my husband has a holy fear of God and he honors and reverences the Lord, and God is giving him the desires of his heart. (Psalms 34:11, 111:10, Proverbs 9:10)
