

## Discouragement & Depression Prayer



**Read and pray these scriptures out loud if you are struggling with discouragement and depression.**

Father God on the authority of Your Word I lift up my brother/sister who is reading this prayer right now and I ask you to break the spirit of oppression, depression, discouragement, doubt and confusion over their life right now - I sever at the root you evil unclean spirit that would try to attack my brother/sister right now and I command you to loose your grip over their home, their property, their lives, their relationships, their finances and their family in Jesus name you have to go and I loose the anointing and the Word of God that sets the captives free. The devil is a thief and a liar and he has come to steal from you, kill and destroy you but Jesus came so you would have life and life more abundantly. You have no power over them according to the Word of God so I cancel your assignment and call it null and void. Get your hands off them for they are God's property. The devil is a liar and he has not truth in him. I sever at the root lying spirits that have whispered in your ear: your not loved, your not wanted, your life doesn't matter, you would be better off dead than to live. Your life does matter and you are so loved by God that He gave His only begotten Son who died on an old rugged cross and took 39 stripes upon His back just for you to be healed and then he shed his blood for you to live a life of freedom and liberty. You are loved and we love you. God has a plan and a purpose for your life. Pick up your Bible and begin to read His promises for you in Jesus righteous holy name. You are Victor not a victim. You are an overcomer by the blood of the Lamb and the Word of your testimony. Start speaking the Word only in your situation and give God something to work with and watch Him turn it all around. All you have to do is whisper the name of Jesus, and say, 'help me Jesus!' He will come running to you and help you. He loves you so very much. Talk to Him like He's your daddy because He is, He is your Heavenly Daddy. Let

Him hold you in His arms and love on you, comfort you and heal you in Jesus name. He is waiting on you with arms wide open.
