Genesis 39:2 Father, I thank You that true success and prosperity is You being with me.

2 Peter 1:3 I thank You that Your "divine power has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness."

2 Corinthians 9:8 Thank you Lord that I "having all sufficiency in everything may have an abundance for every good deed."

Isaiah 55:11 Lord I praise your that your Word goes forth out of my mouth: and it shall not return to You void [without producing any effect, useless], but it shall accomplish that which You please and purpose, and it shall **prosper** in the thing for which I sent it.

Isaiah 58:8 Your light shall break forth like the morning, and my healing (my restoration and the power of a new life) shall spring forth speedily; You are my righteousness (my rightness, my justice, and my right relationship with you O' God) You shall go before Me [conducting me to peace and **prosperity**], and the glory of the Lord shall be my rear guard.

Isaiah 61:9 And my offspring shall be known among the nations and their descendants among the peoples. All who see them [in their **prosperity**] will recognize and acknowledge that they are the people whom the Lord has blessed.

Isaiah 62:3 Thank you Lord that I shall also be [so beautiful and **prosperous** as to be thought of as] a crown of glory and honor in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem [exceedingly beautiful] in the hand of my God.

Zechariah 8:12 I thank you God for there shall the seed produce peace and **prosperity**; the vine shall yield her fruit and the ground shall give its increase and the heavens shall give their dew; and You will cause the remnant of your people to inherit and possess all these things.

Matthew 19:29 Thank you God that anyone and everyone who has **left houses** or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or **lands** for Your name's sake will receive many [even a hundred] times more in this life time and will inherit eternal life.

Luke 6:38 Thank you Lord as I give 1. it is given to me 2. good measure 3. pressed down 4. shaken together and 5. running over 6. men will pour into my lap these are the six blessings I receive every time I give.



1 Corinthians 16:20 Praise the Lord on the first day of every week, each one of our family set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, saving it up, so that when You come no collections will have to be made.

2 Corinthians 8:9 Jesus, I thank You for Your grace, for though You were rich You became poor that I through Your poverty might become rich.
