33. Matthew 6:5

John 4:22-24 (in Context) John 4 (Whole Chapter)

87. John 4:24

For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in **truth.**”

88. John 5:19

So Jesus explained, “I tell you the **truth**, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does.

89. John 5:24

“I tell you the **truth**, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life.

90. John 6:26

Jesus replied, “I tell you the **truth**, you want to be with me because I fed you, not because you understood the miraculous signs.

91. John 6:32

Jesus said, “I tell you the **truth**, Moses didn’t give you bread from heaven. My Father did. And now he offers you the true bread from heaven.

92. John 6:47

“I tell you the **truth**, anyone who believes has eternal life.

93. John 6:53

So Jesus said again, “I tell you the **truth**, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you cannot have eternal life within you.

94. John 7:18

Those who speak for themselves want glory only for themselves, but a person who seeks to honor the one who sent him speaks **truth**, not lies.

95. John 8:26

I have much to say about you and much to condemn, but I won’t. For I say only what I have heard from the one who sent me, and he is completely **truthful**.”

96. John 8:32

And you will know the **truth**, and the **truth** will set you free.”

97. John 8:34

Jesus replied, "I tell you the **truth**, everyone who sins is a slave of sin.

98. John 8:40

Instead, you are trying to kill me because I told you the **truth**, which I heard from God. Abraham never did such a thing.

John 8:44

For you are the children of your father the devil, and you love to do the evil things he does. He was a murderer from the beginning. He has always hated the **truth**, because there is no **truth** in him. When he lies, it is consistent with his character; for he is a liar and the father of lies.

100. John 8:45

So when I tell the **truth**, you just naturally don't believe me!

101. John 8:46

Which of you can **truthfully** accuse me of sin? And since I am telling you the **truth**, why don't you believe me?

102. John 8:51

I tell you the **truth**, anyone who obeys my teaching will never die!"

103. John 8:58

Jesus answered, "I tell you the **truth**, before Abraham was even born, I Am! "

104. John 10:1

[*The Good Shepherd and His Sheep*] "I tell you the **truth**, anyone who sneaks over the wall of a sheepfold, rather than going through the gate, must surely be a thief and a robber!

105. John 10:1-18 "Let me set this before you as plainly as I can. If a person climbs over or through the fence of a sheep pen instead of going through the gate, you know he's up to no good—a sheep rustler! The shepherd walks right up to the gate. The gatekeeper opens the gate to him and the sheep recognize his voice. He calls his

own sheep by name and leads them out. When he gets them all out, he leads them and they follow because they are familiar with his voice. They won't follow a stranger's voice but will scatter because they aren't used to the sound of it."

106. 6-10 Jesus told this simple story, but they had no idea what he was talking about. So he tried again. "I'll be explicit, then. I am the Gate for the sheep. All those others are up to no good—sheep stealers, every one of them. But the sheep didn't listen to them. I am the Gate. Anyone who goes through me will be cared for—will freely go in and out, and find pasture. A thief is only there to steal and kill and destroy. I came so they can have real and eternal life, more and better life than they ever dreamed of.

107. 11-13 "I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd puts the sheep before himself, sacrifices himself if necessary. A hired man is not a real shepherd. The sheep mean nothing to him. He sees a wolf come and runs for it, leaving the sheep to be ravaged and scattered by the wolf. He's only in it for the money. The sheep don't matter to him.

108. 14-18 "I am the Good Shepherd. I know my own sheep and my own sheep know me. In the same way, the Father knows me and I know the Father. I put the sheep before myself, sacrificing myself if necessary. You need to know that I have other sheep in addition to those in this pen. I need to gather and bring them, too. They'll also recognize my voice. Then it will be one flock, one Shepherd. This is why the Father loves me: because I freely lay down my life. And so I am free to take it up again. No one takes it from me. I lay it down of my own free will. I have the right to lay it down; I also have the right to take it up again. I received this authority personally from my Father."

109. John 10:7

so he explained it to them: "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep.

110. John 12:24

I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat is planted in the soil and dies, it remains alone. But its death will produce many new kernels—a plentiful harvest of new lives.

111. John 12:48

But all who reject me and my message will be judged on the day of judgment by the truth I have spoken.

112. John 13:16

I tell you the truth, slaves are not greater than their master. Nor is the messenger

more important than the one who sends the message.

113. John 13:20

I tell you the **truth**, anyone who welcomes my messenger is welcoming me, and anyone who welcomes me is welcoming the Father who sent me.”

114. John 13:21

Now Jesus was deeply troubled, and he exclaimed, “I tell you the **truth**, one of you will betray me!”

115. John 13:38

Jesus answered, “Die for me? I tell you the **truth**, Peter—before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will deny three times that you even know me.

116. John 14:6

Jesus told him, “I am the way, the **truth**, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

117. John 14:12

“I tell you the **truth**, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.

118. John 14:17

He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all **truth**. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you.

119. John 15:26

“But I will send you the Advocate —the Spirit of **truth**. He will come to you from the Father and will testify all about me.

120. John 16:13

When the Spirit of **truth** comes, he will guide you into all **truth**. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future.

John 16:12-14 (in Context) John 16 (Whole Chapter)

121. John 16:20

I tell you the **truth**, you will weep and mourn over what is going to happen to me, but the world will rejoice. You will grieve, but your grief will suddenly turn to wonderful joy.

122. John 16:23

At that time you won't need to ask me for anything. I tell you the **truth**, you will ask the Father directly, and he will grant your request because you use my name.

John 16:22-24 (in Context) John 16 (Whole Chapter)

123. John 17:17

Make them holy by your **truth**; teach them your word, which is **truth**.

124. John 17:19

And I give myself as a holy sacrifice for them so they can be made holy by your **truth**.

125. John 18:23

Jesus replied, "If I said anything wrong, you must prove it. But if I'm speaking the **truth**, why are you beating me?"

126. John 18:37

Pilate said, "So you are a king?" Jesus responded, "You say I am a king. Actually, I was born and came into the world to testify to the **truth**. All who love the **truth** recognize that what I say is true."

127. John 18:38

"What is **truth**?" Pilate asked. Then he went out again to the people and told them, "He is not guilty of any crime."

128. John 19:35

(This report is from an eyewitness giving an accurate account. He speaks the **truth** so that you also can believe.)

129. John 21:18

"I tell you the **truth**, when you were young, you were able to do as you liked; you dressed yourself and went wherever you wanted to go. But when you are old, you

will stretch out your hands, and others will dress you and take you where you don't want to go."

130. Acts 7:51

"You stubborn people! You are heathen at heart and deaf to the **truth**. Must you forever resist the Holy Spirit? That's what your ancestors did, and so do you!

131. Acts 17:11

And the people of Berea were more open-minded than those in Thessalonica, and they listened eagerly to Paul's message. They searched the Scriptures day after day to see if Paul and Silas were teaching the **truth**.

132. Acts 20:30

Even some men from your own group will rise up and distort the **truth** in order to draw a following.

133. Acts 21:34

Some shouted one thing and some another. Since he couldn't find out the **truth** in all the uproar and confusion, he ordered that Paul be taken to the fortress.

134. Romans 1:18

[*God's Anger at Sin*] But God shows his anger from heaven against all sinful, wicked people who suppress the **truth** by their wickedness.

135. Romans 1:19

They know the **truth** about God because he has made it obvious to them.

136. Romans 1:25

They traded the **truth** about God for a lie. So they worshiped and served the things God created instead of the Creator himself, who is worthy of eternal praise! Amen.

137. Romans 2:8

But he will pour out his anger and wrath on those who live for themselves, who refuse to obey the **truth** and instead live lives of wickedness.

138. Romans 2:20

You think you can instruct the ignorant and teach children the ways of God. For you are certain that God's law gives you complete knowledge and **truth**.

139. Romans 3:7

"But," someone might still argue, "how can God condemn me as a sinner if my dishonesty highlights his **truthfulness** and brings him more glory?"

140. Romans 9:1

[*God's Selection of Israel*] With Christ as my witness, I speak with utter **truthfulness**. My conscience and the Holy Spirit confirm it.

141. 1 Corinthians 2:13

When we tell you these things, we do not use words that come from human wisdom. Instead, we speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit's words to explain spiritual **truths**.

142. 1 Corinthians 2:14

But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these **truths** from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means.

143. 1 Corinthians 5:8

So let us celebrate the festival, not with the old bread of wickedness and evil, but with the new bread of sincerity and **truth**.

144. 1 Corinthians 13:6

It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the **truth** wins out.

145. 2 Corinthians 1:23

Now I call upon God as my witness that I am telling the **truth**. The reason I didn't return to Corinth was to spare you from a severe rebuke.

146. 2 Corinthians 3:14

But the people's minds were hardened, and to this day whenever the old covenant is being read, the same veil covers their minds so they cannot understand the **truth**.

And this veil can be removed only by believing in Christ.

147. 2 Corinthians 4:2

We reject all shameful deeds and underhanded methods. We don't try to trick anyone or distort the word of God. We tell the **truth** before God, and all who are honest know this.

148. 2 Corinthians 6:7

We faithfully preach the **truth**. God's power is working in us. We use the weapons of righteousness in the right hand for attack and the left hand for defense.

149. 2 Corinthians 7:14

I had told him how proud I was of you—and you didn't disappoint me. I have always told you the **truth**, and now my boasting to Titus has also proved true!

150. 2 Corinthians 11:10

As surely as the **truth** of Christ is in me, no one in all of Greece will ever stop me from boasting about this.

151. 2 Corinthians 12:6

If I wanted to boast, I would be no fool in doing so, because I would be telling the **truth**. But I won't do it, because I don't want anyone to give me credit beyond what they can see in my life or hear in my message,

152. 2 Corinthians 13:8

For we cannot oppose the **truth**, but must always stand for the **truth**.

153. Galatians 1:7

but is not the Good News at all. You are being fooled by those who deliberately twist the **truth** concerning Christ.

154. Galatians 2:5

But we refused to give in to them for a single moment. We wanted to preserve the **truth** of the gospel message for you.

155. Galatians 2:14

When I saw that they were not following the **truth** of the gospel message, I said to Peter in front of all the others, “Since you, a Jew by birth, have discarded the Jewish laws and are living like a Gentile, why are you now trying to make these Gentiles follow the Jewish traditions?”

156. Galatians 4:16

Have I now become your enemy because I am telling you the **truth**?

157. Galatians 5:7

You were running the race so well. Who has held you back from following the **truth**?

158. Ephesians 1:13

And now you Gentiles have also heard the **truth**, the Good News that God saves you. And when you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom he promised long ago.

159. Ephesians 4:14

Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the **truth**.

160. Ephesians 4:15

Instead, we will speak the **truth** in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.

161. Ephesians 4:21

Since you have heard about Jesus and have learned the **truth** that comes from him, Ephesians 4:20-22 (in Context) Ephesians 4 (Whole Chapter)

162. Ephesians 4:25

So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the **truth**, for we are all parts of the same body.

Ephesians 4:24-26 (in Context) Ephesians 4 (Whole Chapter)

163. Ephesians 6:14

Stand your ground, putting on the belt of **truth** and the body armor of God's

righteousness.

164. Philippians 1:7

So it is right that I should feel as I do about all of you, for you have a special place in my heart. You share with me the special favor of God, both in my imprisonment and in defending and confirming the **truth** of the Good News.

165. Colossians 1:5

which come from your confident hope of what God has reserved for you in heaven. You have had this expectation ever since you first heard the **truth** of the Good News.

166. Colossians 1:6

This same Good News that came to you is going out all over the world. It is bearing fruit everywhere by changing lives, just as it changed your lives from the day you first heard and understood the **truth** about God's wonderful grace.

167. Colossians 1:23

But you must continue to believe this **truth** and stand firmly in it. Don't drift away from the assurance you received when you heard the Good News. The Good News has been preached all over the world, and I, Paul, have been appointed as God's servant to proclaim it.

168. Colossians 2:7

Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the **truth** you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.

169. 2 Thessalonians 2:10

He will use every kind of evil deception to fool those on their way to destruction, because they refuse to love and accept the **truth** that would save them.

170. 2 Thessalonians 2:12

Then they will be condemned for enjoying evil rather than believing the **truth**.

171. 2 Thessalonians 2:13

[*Believers Should Stand Firm*] As for us, we can't help but thank God for you, dear brothers and sisters loved by the Lord. We are always thankful that God chose you to be among the first to experience salvation—a salvation that came through the Spirit who makes you holy and through your belief in the **truth**.

172. 1 Timothy 1:3

[*Warnings against False Teachings*] When I left for Macedonia, I urged you to stay there in Ephesus and stop those whose teaching is contrary to the **truth**.

173. 1 Timothy 2:4

who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the **truth**.

1 Timothy 2:3-5 (in Context) 1 Timothy 2 (Whole Chapter)

174. 1 Timothy 2:7

And I have been chosen as a preacher and apostle to teach the Gentiles this message about faith and **truth**. I'm not exaggerating—just telling the **truth**.

175. 1 Timothy 3:14

[*The Truths of Our Faith*] I am writing these things to you now, even though I hope to be with you soon,

176. 1 Timothy 3:15

so that if I am delayed, you will know how people must conduct themselves in the household of God. This is the church of the living God, which is the pillar and foundation of the **truth**.

177. 1 Timothy 4:3

They will say it is wrong to be married and wrong to eat certain foods. But God created those foods to be eaten with thanks by faithful people who know the **truth**.

1 Timothy 4:2-4 (in Context) 1 Timothy 4 (Whole Chapter)

178. 1 Timothy 6:5

These people always cause trouble. Their minds are corrupt, and they have turned their backs on the **truth**. To them, a show of godliness is just a way to become wealthy.

179. 2 Timothy 1:14

Through the power of the Holy Spirit who lives within us, carefully guard the precious **truth** that has been entrusted to you.

180. 2 Timothy 2:2

You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these **truths** to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.

181. 2 Timothy 2:15

[*An Approved Worker*] Work hard so you can present yourself to God and receive his approval. Be a good worker, one who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly explains the word of **truth**.

182. 2 Timothy 2:18

They have left the path of **truth**, claiming that the resurrection of the dead has already occurred; in this way, they have turned some people away from the faith.

183. 2 Timothy 2:19

But God's **truth** stands firm like a foundation stone with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and "All who belong to the Lord must turn away from evil."

184. 2 Timothy 2:25

Gently instruct those who oppose the **truth**. Perhaps God will change those people's hearts, and they will learn the **truth**.

185. 2 Timothy 3:7

(Such women are forever following new teachings, but they are never able to understand the **truth**.)

186. 2 Timothy 3:8

These teachers oppose the **truth** just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses. They have depraved minds and a counterfeit faith.

187. 2 Timothy 4:4

They will reject the **truth** and chase after myths.

188. Titus 1:1

[*Greetings from Paul*] This letter is from Paul, a slave of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ. I have been sent to proclaim faith to those God has chosen and to teach them to know the **truth** that shows them how to live godly lives.

189. Titus 1:2

This **truth** gives them confidence that they have eternal life, which God—who does not lie—promised them before the world began.

190. Titus 1:11

They must be silenced, because they are turning whole families away from the **truth** by their false teaching. And they do it only for money.

191. Titus 1:14

They must stop listening to Jewish myths and the commands of people who have turned away from the **truth**.

192. Titus 2:8

Teach the **truth** so that your teaching can't be criticized. Then those who oppose us will be ashamed and have nothing bad to say about us.

193. Titus 3:11

For people like that have turned away from the **truth**, and their own sins condemn them.

194. Hebrews 2:1

[*A Warning against Drifting Away*] So we must listen very carefully to the **truth** we have heard, or we may drift away from it.

195. Hebrews 3:5

Moses was certainly faithful in God's house as a servant. His work was an illustration

of the **truths** God would reveal later.

196. Hebrews 10:26

Dear friends, if we deliberately continue sinning after we have received knowledge of the **truth**, there is no longer any sacrifice that will cover these sins.

197. James 3:14

But if you are bitterly jealous and there is selfish ambition in your heart, don't cover up the **truth** with boasting and lying.

198. James 5:19

[*Restore Wandering Believers*] My dear brothers and sisters, if someone among you wanders away from the **truth** and is brought back,

199. 1 Peter 1:22

You were cleansed from your sins when you obeyed the **truth**, so now you must show sincere love to each other as brothers and sisters. Love each other deeply with all your heart.

200. 2 Peter 1:12

[*Paying Attention to Scripture*] Therefore, I will always remind you about these things—even though you already know them and are standing firm in the **truth** you have been taught.

201. 2 Peter 2:2

Many will follow their evil teaching and shameful immorality. And because of these teachers, the way of **truth** will be slandered.

202. 2 Peter 2:22

They prove the **truth** of this proverb: "A dog returns to its vomit." And another says, "A washed pig returns to the mud."

203. 2 Peter 3:3

Most importantly, I want to remind you that in the last days scoffers will come,

mocking the **truth** and following their own desires.

204. 1 John 1:6

So we are lying if we say we have fellowship with God but go on living in spiritual darkness; we are not practicing the **truth**.

205. 1 John 1:8

If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the **truth**.

206. 1 John 2:4

If someone claims, "I know God," but doesn't obey God's commandments, that person is a liar and is not living in the **truth**.

207. 1 John 2:8

Yet it is also new. Jesus lived the **truth** of this commandment, and you also are living it. For the darkness is disappearing, and the true light is already shining.

208. 1 John 2:20

But you are not like that, for the Holy One has given you his Spirit, and all of you know the **truth**.

209. 1 John 2:21

So I am writing to you not because you don't know the **truth** but because you know the difference between **truth** and lies.

210. 1 John 3:18

Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the **truth** by our actions.

211. 1 John 3:19

Our actions will show that we belong to the **truth**, so we will be confident when we stand before God.

212. 1 John 4:3

But if someone claims to be a prophet and does not acknowledge the **truth** about Jesus, that person is not from God. Such a person has the spirit of the Antichrist, which you heard is coming into the world and indeed is already here.

213. 1 John 4:6

But we belong to God, and those who know God listen to us. If they do not belong to God, they do not listen to us. That is how we know if someone has the Spirit of **truth** or the spirit of deception.

214. 1 John 5:6

And Jesus Christ was revealed as God's Son by his baptism in water and by shedding his blood on the cross —not by water only, but by water and blood. And the Spirit, who is **truth**, confirms it with his testimony.

215. 2 John 1:1

[*Greetings*] This letter is from John, the elder. I am writing to the chosen lady and to her children, whom I love in the **truth**—as does everyone else who knows the **truth**—

216. 2 John 1:2

because the **truth** lives in us and will be with us forever.

217. 2 John 1:3

Grace, mercy, and peace, which come from God the Father and from Jesus Christ—the Son of the Father—will continue to be with us who live in **truth** and love.

218. 2 John 1:4

[*Live in the Truth*] How happy I was to meet some of your children and find them living according to the **truth**, just as the Father commanded.**2 John 1:10**

If anyone comes to your meeting and does not teach the **truth** about Christ, don't invite that person into your home or give any kind of encouragement.

2 John 1:9-11 (in Context) 2 John 1 (Whole Chapter)

219. 3 John 1:1

[*Greetings*] This letter is from John, the elder. I am writing to Gaius, my dear friend, whom I love in the **truth**.

220. 3 John 1:3

Some of the traveling teachers recently returned and made me very happy by telling me about your faithfulness and that you are living according to the **truth**.

221. 3 John 1:4

I could have no greater joy than to hear that my children are following the **truth**.

222. 3 John 1:8

So we ourselves should support them so that we can be their partners as they teach the **truth**.

223. 3 John 1:12

Everyone speaks highly of Demetrius, as does the **truth** itself. We ourselves can say the same for him, and you know we speak the **truth**.

224. Revelation 2:24

“But I also have a message for the rest of you in Thyatira who have not followed this false teaching (‘deeper **truths**,’ as they call them—depths of Satan, actually). I will ask nothing more of you.
