Ecclesiastes 1:16

Ecclesiastes 2:26

God gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy to those who please him. But if a sinner becomes wealthy, God takes the wealth away and gives it to those who please him. This, too, is meaningless—like chasing the wind.

Ecclesiastes 7:1

[*Wisdom for Life*] A good reputation is more valuable than costly perfume. And the day you die is better than the day you are born.

Ecclesiastes 7:11-12

Wisdom is even better when you have money. Both are a benefit as you go through life. Wisdom and money can get you almost anything, but only wisdom can save your life.

Ecclesiastes 7:15

[*The Limits of Human Wisdom*] I have seen everything in this meaningless life, including the death of good young people and the long life of wicked people.

Ecclesiastes 7:23

I have always tried my best to let wisdom guide my thoughts and actions. I said to myself, "I am determined to be wise." But it didn't work.

Romans 11:33
